

## CALL FOR HASTING CANCER TRUST FUNDING APPLICATIONS

For many years the Hastings Cancer Trust has translated the generosity of the local community into much needed funding for a range of projects supporting cancer patients and clinicians within our local area. Importantly these projects have all been selected from submissions received as part of our Annual Grants Program.

The Trust will call for applications each year between August and October.

The window for submitting an application opens each year on the first Monday in August and submissions must be received by 5.00pm on the first Friday in October of the same year.

Applications for a Hastings Cancer Trust Grant can be submitted by, or on behalf of, anyone involved in the management of cancer, or community organisations that support cancer patients, cancer survivors and their carers in the Hastings, Camden Haven and Macleay areas.

To assist with the application process, we have introduced a simple template which will guide you through the necessary information required to support your application.

You have 2 options to access and complete the form.

- 1. Complete and submit the template on line directly from the link above.
- 2. Go to the link, download the word doc form and complete off line. When finished the form can be sent

Our trustees will pay attention to how the project will benefit the maximum number of people with cancer, and those recovering from cancer.

Where resources are not available to allow full funding of an application, detailed costing would provide scope for the trustees to consider part-funding for a project. Applications where other matching funding sources are outlined will also be looked upon favourably.

Projects might include the development of facilities, support of local research efforts, funding for the education and training of clinicians, purchase of aids and equipment, and provision for the specific needs of community groups.

Please note submissions must be lodged and received by 5.00pm on the first Friday in October.

All applicants will be notified of the result of their application by mail or email later in October and the successful applicants will be invited to attend a formal presentation in November.
